

**CHICAGO DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT TO IMPLEMENT ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE
LEARNING PROJECTS AT 15 HIGH SCHOOLS**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement (the "Agreement") with the City of Chicago
Department of Environment to implement environmental service learning projects at 15 high schools. The

Board's Office of High School Development and the Department of Environment (DOE) desire to engage high school and elementary school students in meaningful service opportunities that develop and support sustainable improvements to the physical environment of neighborhoods throughout the City of Chicago. A written agreement is currently being negotiated. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of this Board Report
