

AMEND BOARD REPORT 01-0425-PO1 GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC REPRESENTATION

The Chicago Board of Education is committed to increasing public input in its decision-making process. That

The Public Participation portion of the Board's regularly scheduled meetings will be conducted between 10:00 A.M. and 11:30 P.M. prior to each daytime meeting and between 2:00 P.M. and 8:00 P.M. for every evening meeting. Any individual interested in making a presentation must register with the office of the Board in person between 8:30 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. on the day of the daytime meeting and between 2:00 P.M. and 3:30 P.M. on the day of the evening meeting.

Presentations must be limited to issues of concern before the Board and comments of a personal nature directed toward individual Board Members, employees or individual.

- Registration must be made in person by the individual who will make the presentation. Representatives may not sign up another speaker.

- It is the Chair's prerogative to limit the discussion of any speaker's participation.
- Speakers will have two (2) minutes each to present their remarks.
