WHEREAS, in 1998 the Board of Education of the City of Chicago (the "Board") adopted Resolution ... TO UNDERTAKE THE ACQUISITION FOR AND THE ABLA COMMUNITY CENTER ... and

WHEREAS funds are now needed to permit the design and construction of the ABLA Project and the Board's ABLA Project relative to the amount of space on the community center property presently construction for the ABLA Project anticipated to be utilized by the Board; and

WHEREAS an Commission Surplus Fund Account, the City Surplus Fund Account, or such similar account (the "Surplus Account") and Commission Surplus Fund Account, of such similar account (the "Commission Surplus Fund Account")

WHEREAS the Board has determined that it is necessary, desirable, advantageous, and in the public interest to undertake the ABLA Project in conjunction with the City, the District and the other governmental entities, and

WHEREAS, the ABLA Project will maximize the utilization of educational facilities operated and maintained by the Board by providing additional educational options and enhanced recreational and other facilities and improving
