Consultant was selected on a non-competitive basis because of the professionalism required to render these services. A written agreement for Consultant's services is attached hereto. FINANCIAL – Chicago Law Department \$105,000 per annum review of Financial**GENERAL CONDITIONS**

The agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education may conduct investigations.

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education may conduct investigations.

The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of the Chicago Board of Education's Code of Ethics which restricts the employment of certain individuals or former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

~~Indebtedness~~ – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-FX2) as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

~~September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RH3)~~ as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability – The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year, notwithstanding the best of good faith, is the subsequent financial responsibility of the Board.
