

FARE CARDS AND TRANSFERS

AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE AND APPROVE PAYMENT OF CTA FARE CARDS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the purchase and approve payment of fare cards from the Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) at a cost not to exceed \$80,000.00. The fare cards shall not exceed \$620,000.00 and address the purchase of CTA transfers at a cost not to exceed \$80,000.00. The fare cards shall be used for transfers as required pursuant to a court order in Case # 92-91-570.

Salazar v. Edwards, which mandates that the Chicago Board of Education provide transportation services to homeless students in accordance with the Illinois State Board of Education. For Homeless Children Act. No contract is required for this purchase. Information pertinent to this purchase is stated below.

Bank or any other financial institution to receive checks/warrants for conversion to small cash denominations for students to purchase CTA transfers which are not included in the CTA fare card provided such cash conversion service is at no charge to the Board.

Chicago Board of Education Report also authorizes the use of Amalgamote checks/warrants for conversion to small cash denominations included in the CTA fare card provided such cash conversion service is at no charge to the Board.
