

**RESOLUTION
REQUEST THE PUBLIC BUILDING COMMISSION OF CHICAGO TO**

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is necessary, desirable, advantageous, and in the public interest to undertake various capital projects in conjunction with the City of Chicago and other governmental agencies; and

WHEREAS, the projects would maximize the utilization of educational facilities operated and maintained by the Board by providing new school

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION:

1. The Commission is hereby requested to construct a new McNair Area School on behalf of the Board.
