THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Adjust Local School Council voting district for Mark Skinner elementary school pursuant to 105 ILCS 5/34-2.1c.

The existing local school council voting district for Mark Skinner elementary school needs to be expanded in order to more fully encompass the community surrounding the school. The proposed new boundaries will encompass all schools without attendance areas. State law allows local school council community boundaries to change every two years. The boundaries of the local school council for Mark Skinner elementary school have not been changed since its inception on September 7, 1991.

Effective immediately, the Local School Council voting district of the Mark

Skinner elementary school shall encompass the geographic boundaries set forth below.

Beginning at Ashland Avenue and Grand Avenue

East to Lake Michigan

South to North Avenue

West to Ashland Avenue

North to the starting point
