Pursuant to an existing Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA"), the Board, in conjunction with the City of Chicago's Department of Environment (DOE), provides environmental service learning opportunities for students in the environment of neighborhoods throughout the City of Chicago. The Board is authorized to approve the continued funding of these projects for the 2001-2002 school year.
