

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE CHIEF OF DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES
SUBJECT: EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAM

THE CITY OF CHICAGO AND THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE CHIEF OF DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES
The City of Chicago and the Chief of Police and the Chief of Department of Social Services have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the purpose of providing early childhood education to children in the City of Chicago. The MOU provides for the City of Chicago to provide the necessary facilities and personnel for the program. The MOU also provides for the City of Chicago to provide the necessary funding for the program. The MOU is currently being negotiated. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event that the MOU is not executed within 90 days of the date of this MOU. The information in this agreement is stated below.

The MOU shall be in full force and effect from the date of execution until the date of termination. The MOU shall be extended for two (2) additional years unless the parties have agreed in writing to terminate the MOU. The MOU shall be terminated if the City of Chicago fails to provide the necessary funding for the program.

The purpose of this program is to carry out facilities improvements which will serve to expand the number of Head Start classrooms operated by CPS. This is a multi-year project under which the City of Chicago will provide the necessary funding for the program.
