

ADOPT BOARD RULE 6-32, CHANGE OF AN ATTENDANCE CENTER'S LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTION DATE

THE GENERAL COUNSEL RECOMMENDS:

The General Counsel recommends adopting Board Rule 6-32 as follows:

DESCRIPTION:

Upon the recommendation of the General Superintendent, the Board may change the date of the first semester report card pick-up day to increase parents' and community involvement as candidates and electors. All other circumstances that would deny the parents or legal guardians the next full term opportunity to participate as either candidates or electors in any local school council election for the attendance center or from the list of the students anticipated enrollment in the attendance center.
