Continued retention of Fredrick H. Bates, Esq.

**DESCRIPTION:** The General Counsel has continued the retention of Fredrick H. Bates, Esq., who has served as an independent investigator in the proceedings convened pursuant to section 5/34 of the Illinois School Code and the Board's policy on the closing and consolidation of schools. In addition, the General Counsel has retained Mr. Bates to represent the Board in its defense against the complaint filed by the Chicago Teachers Union, Local 100, in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, in the case of *Chicago Teachers Union, Local 100 v. Chicago Board of Education*, Case No. 01-cv-00001, in accordance with section 5/34 of the Illinois School Code. This agreement shall be reviewed by the General Counsel and, if satisfactory, processed.
