This program helps students extend and enhance their achievement in reading and mathematics as they progress through the school year. The program will improve the academic performance of students in reading and mathematics. The program will enhance the students' education and career goals, and it will increase the number of students eligible to attend the University of Illinois at Chicago.

PROGRAM: The CPS Prep Program is primarily within the CHA Community Schools and mathematics as they progress through the school year.

COMPENSATION: The University of Illinois at Chicago will be paid approximately \$11,000 per student for the summer months.
