

**RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE WENDELL PHILLIPS HIGH SCHOOL  
AS A CHICAGO LANDMARK**

**WHEREAS**, on October 3, 2002, the City of Chicago, Department of Planning and Development, recommended to the Commission on Chicago Landmarks, the proposed designation of Wendell Phillips High School as a Chicago Landmark ; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed designation supports the City's overall planning goals for the Bronzeville Area and is consistent with the City's governing policies and plans and

Bronzeville community as a prominent educational and social center for the African American community for the past one hundred years; and

**WHEREAS**, Wendell Phillips High School remains a strong example of the Neo-Classical school of architecture, a building built in the first quarter of the twentieth century, and

**WHEREAS**, Wendell Phillips High School was identified in the *Chicago Historic Resource Survey* as a Chicago Historic Landmark;

**WHEREAS**, the designation would complement the City's continuing efforts to identify and preserve the rich architectural and historical heritage of the Bronzeville community.

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Education, Members of the Chicago Board of Education, gathered here this 18 day of December, that Wendell Phillips High School be designated as a Chicago Landmark and that any documents necessary to effectuate this designation be executed by the Board's General Counsel.
