

**RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE WENDELL PHILLIPS HIGH SCHOOL
AS A CHICAGO LANDMARK**

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2002, the City of Chicago, Department of Planning and Development, recommended to the Commission on Chicago Landmarks, the proposed designation of Wendell Phillips High School as a Chicago Landmark ; and

WHEREAS, the proposed designation supports the City's overall planning goals for the Bronzeville Area and is consistent with the City's governing policies and plans and

Bronzeville community as a prominent educational and social center for the African American community for the past one hundred years; and

WHEREAS, Wendell Phillips High School remains a strong example of the Neo-Classical school of architecture, a building built in the first quarter of the twentieth century, and

WHEREAS, Wendell Phillips High School was identified in the *Chicago Historic Resource Survey* as a Chicago Historic Resource

WHEREAS, the designation would complement the City's continuing efforts to identify and preserve the rich architectural and historical heritage of the Bronzeville community.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Education, Members of the Chicago Board of Education gathered here this 18 day of December that Wendell Phillips High School be designated as a Chicago Landmark and that any documents necessary to effectuate this designation be executed by the Board's General Counsel
