

PAULEY ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEWBERRY LIBRARY FOR CONSULTING SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

... entering into an agreement with The Newberry Library to provide consulting services to the Office of Curriculum and Instruction/Department of Curriculum at a cost not to exceed \$154,273. Consultant began services without prior Board approval. Consultant was selected on a non-competitive basis because Consultant was identified as the only individual in the Chicago area with the necessary skills to coordinate the Department of Curriculum and Instruction's ongoing work on the Chicago Story Project. Consultant is a former writer and editor of the Chicago Tribune. The agreement shall automatically renew for one year if the agreement is not executed within 60 days of the date of this Board Report. 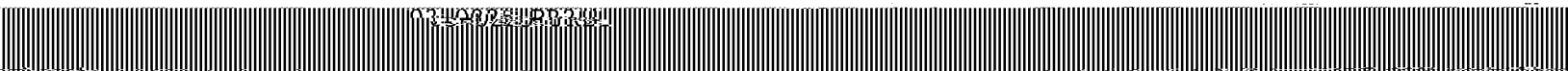
