The program began without prior Board approval. Roosevelt University has agreed to give the Board a 40% tuition reduction. The program is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Roosevelt University until the Board has approved the program.

TERM: The term of this agreement shall commence on February 1, 2003 and shall end on December 31, 2004.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT: 60 days notice by the Board.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Roosevelt shall offer courses leading to a masters degree in special education certification with a Learning and Behavior Specialist endorsement to 25 FPPs in Chicago Public Schools' special education programs (job code #0000044).

PARTICIPANTS: All FPPs shall have passed the Illinois State Board of Education Basic Skills Test before being admitted into the FACE Program. Participants shall be selected by the Board of Education. Each Participant shall sign an agreement that commits them to the program.

DELIVERABLES: Roosevelt shall offer a masters program in special education certification with a Learning and Behavior Specialist endorsement for a total of 35 credit hours.
