The official Honorary Student Board Member shall be an honorary nonvoting office

- In order to be eligible to serve as an Honorary Student Board Member a student shall be either any of grades 9 through 12 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade and shall have been elected by his/her the student body of his/her school to serve as LSC student representative council president, vice-president, treasurer or secretary.
- In order to be eligible to serve as an Honorary Student Board Member, a student will shall

- All vacancies in the office of Honorary Student Board Member vacancies shall be for the unexpired portion of the member's term filled pursuant to an election a non-binding advisory

The Honorary Student Board Member shall:

- Serve as a non-binding advisory body to the Board of Education on issues of concern to students
