APPROVE OUT OF DISTRICT PUBLIC SCHOOL TUITION PAYMENTS TO PUBLIC

SCHOOLS OUTSIDE OF CHICAGO FOR STUDENTS WITH SEVERE DISABILITIES AND/OR SEVERE SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROBLEMS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve out of district tuition payments to public schools outside of Chicago for students with severe

disabilities and/or severe substance abuse problems at a cost not to exceed \$ 2,600,000.00 in the aggregate. No written agreement is required for these tuition payments. Information pertinent to these payments is stated below.

TERM OF PAYMENTS: July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004

SERVICES: Payments of tuition on a per capita basis are made for students who are residents of the Chicago Public School district and attend public schools outside of Chicago. Currently, 32 students have been placed residentially through a state agency and reside too far from Chicago to be transported to Chicago Public Schools and an additional 73 students require unique and complex special education
