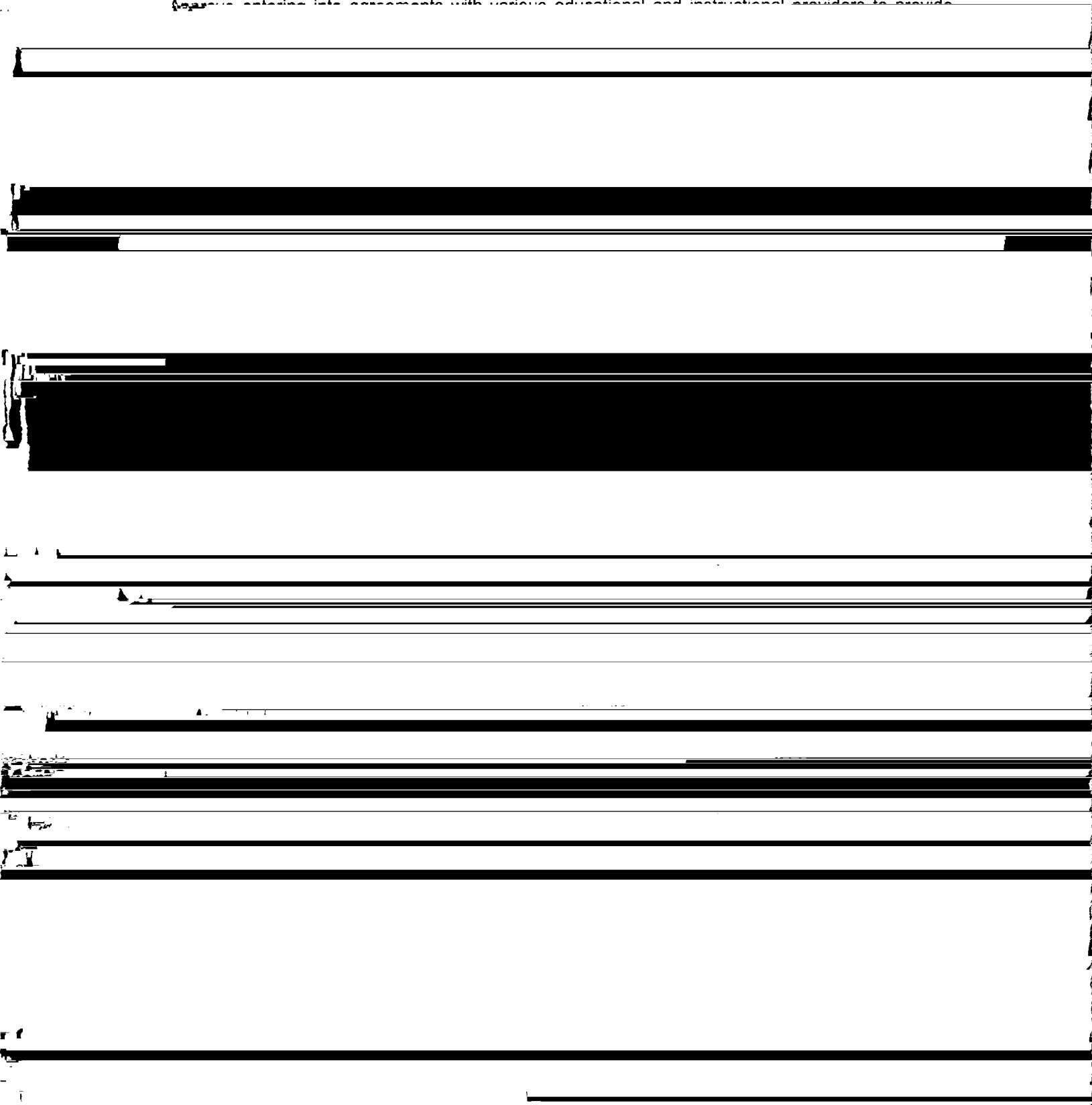


**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AGREEMENTS WITH ISBE-APPROVED
