## RATIFY AN AGREEMENT WITH DEPAUL CENTER FOR URBAN EDUCATION FOR CONSULTING SERVICES

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-	Ratify an agreement with DePaul Center for Urban Education to provide consulting services to Johnson Elementary School at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.00. These services were provided without prior Board approval. Consultant was selected on a non-competitive basis because of its quality programs offered at other schools, because it will individualize its services to meet the specific needs of Johnson Elementary School,
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- 3. Course for Assessment Coordinator with correlated in-school application
- 4. Coordination of Connectors, including monitoring of on-line reporting
- 5. Assistance in planning school improvement
- 6. Connector workshops at DePaul or a Museum
- 7. CPDU recertification credit unit option for all workshops
- 8. Administrator forum once each semester
- 9. Ordering and orientation to teacher resources including computers or digital cameras for teachers
- 10. Minimum of five On-site workshops with subsequent evaluation reports

## **OUTCOMES:** Consultant's services shall result in:

- i. Increased student achievement in core curriculum as measured by ISAT and ITBS.
- ii. Teachers will work with increased clarity.
- iii. Students will work with increased focus and responsibility.
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Contingent Liability – The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).
