
RATIFY AN AGREEMENT WITH DEPAUL CENTER FOR URBAN EDUCATION AND ASSESSMENT

er i Citie THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION: Ratify an agreement with DePaul Center for Urban Education and Assessment to provide consulting services to Talman Elementary School at a cost not to exceed \$33,500. These services were obtained without prior Board approval. Consultant was selected on a non-competitive basis because of the quality of its program as seen through research and because the DePaul "Connections" Program is aligned with the State Goals and promotes standard-based instruction and the Chicago Reading Initiative. A written agreement for Consultant's services is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Consultant prior to the execution of the written agreement.
