

**APPROVE EXERCISING THE FIRST OPTION TO EXTEND THE PRE-QUALIFICATION STATUS OF
AND THE AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS CONTRACTORS TO PROVIDE INTEGRATED PEST
MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve exercising the first option to extend the pre-qualification status of and the agreements with various contractors to provide integrated pest management services to the Department of Operations at a cost for the option period not to exceed \$1,134,000 in the aggregate. Written documents exercising this option are currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to any Contractor during the option period except the

execution of such contractor's written document. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING: There is one option period for one year remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Contractors will continue to provide the following services:
furnishing all supervision, labor, materials, and equipment necessary to perform the following:

- Conduct an initial facility survey,
- Develop a Comprehensive Integrated Pest Management Plan,
- Perform routine inspections for signs of pests, suppress designated pests,
- Develop and keep records pertaining to pest management at each facility in accordance with the IPM plan,
- Respond to pest emergencies,
- Provide recommendations for structural and procedural modifications necessary to achieve pest

prevention, and

- Perform surveillance, trapping, and pesticide application components of the IPM Plan.

DELIVERABLES: Contractors will continue to provide a Comprehensive IPM Plan, Pest Surveillance data

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

~~Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions~~
