APPROVE HEARING OFFICER'S FINDING THAT PUPIL IS A NON-RESIDENT OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO NOT ENTITLED TO ATTEND THE CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS ON A TUITION-FREE BASIS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That the Chicago Board of Education: adopt the March 13, 2007 findings of the Board-appointed Hearing Officer from a Pupil Residency Hearing held February 21, 2007, that: (i) the pupil (I.D. No. 42039365) has been and is a non-resident of the City of Chicago not entitled to attend the Chicago Public Schools on a tuition-free basis; and (ii) the pupil's parent(s) is (are) indebted to the Board for non-resident tuition for the pupil's attendance in the Chicago Public Schools since September 2002 in the total amount of \$33,029.87; and reject any objections to the hearing officer's findings filed by the parents on or about March 24, 2007.
