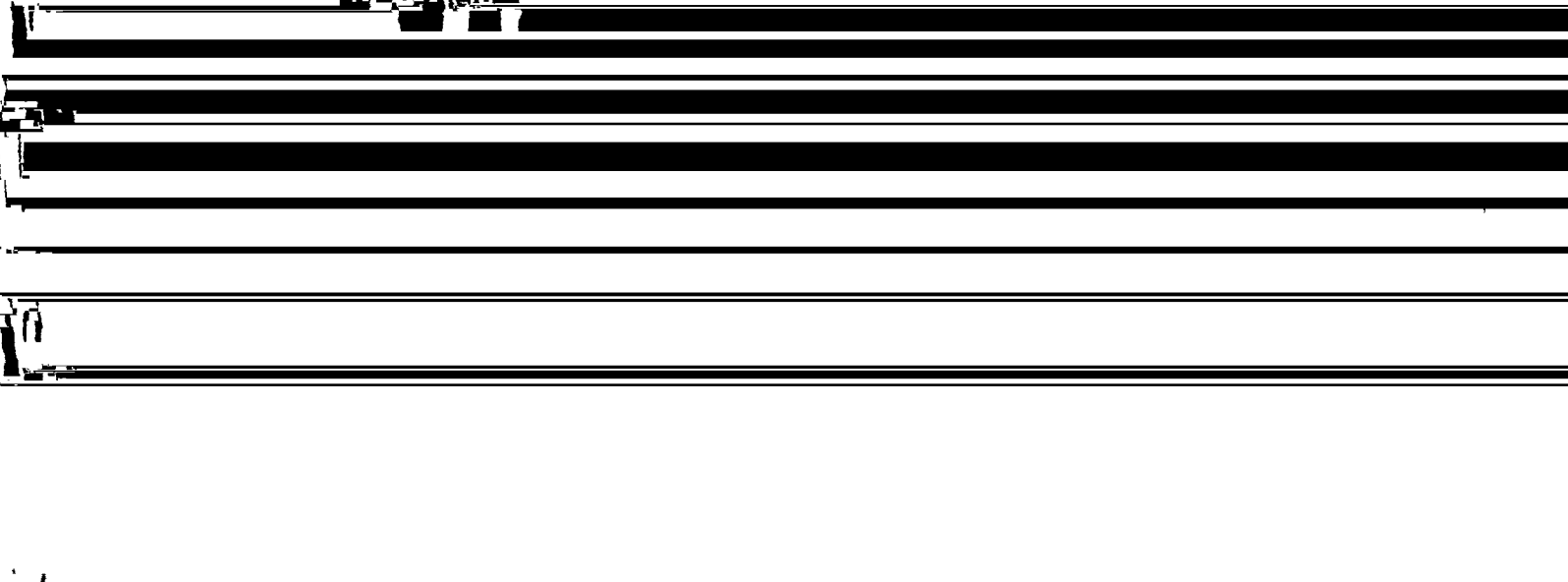


APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CHRISTY WEBBER & COMPANY
