


**OUTCOMES:** Provider services shall result in the following:

- 1. Increased student social/emotional competencies.
- 2. Implementation of proven practices to promote social/emotional learning by CPS staff.
- 3. Increase availability of support services for students and their families in high need areas.
- 4. Increased capacity of CPS to provide training opportunities for school staff in high need areas.

**COMPENSATION:** Each Provider shall be paid a negotiated rate for services as detailed in each Provider's renewal agreement. Compensation shall not to exceed \$73,300.00 \$282,163.00 in the aggregate for the one year extension term.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written renewal agreements <u>and amendments</u>. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the renewal agreements <u>and amendments</u>. Authorize the Chief Specialized Services Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate these renewal agreements <u>and amendments</u>.
