

ADJUST ATTENDANCE AREAS FOR KILMER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, HAYT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, CLINTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND PEIRCE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective July 1, 2008, adjust attendance boundaries for Kilmer Elementary, located at 6700 North Greenview Avenue, Stephen K. Hayt Elementary, located at 1518 West Granville Avenue, DeWitt Clinton Elementary, located at 2418 North Eastfield Avenue, and Milton C. Peirce Elementary School, located at 1423 West Bryn Mawr Avenue.

International Studies, located at 1423 West Bryn Mawr Avenue.

A public meeting was convened on Friday, November 16, 2007 at the Board of Chambers; and second public meeting was held on February 13, 2008 both to discuss and receive comments on the proposed

boundary change.
