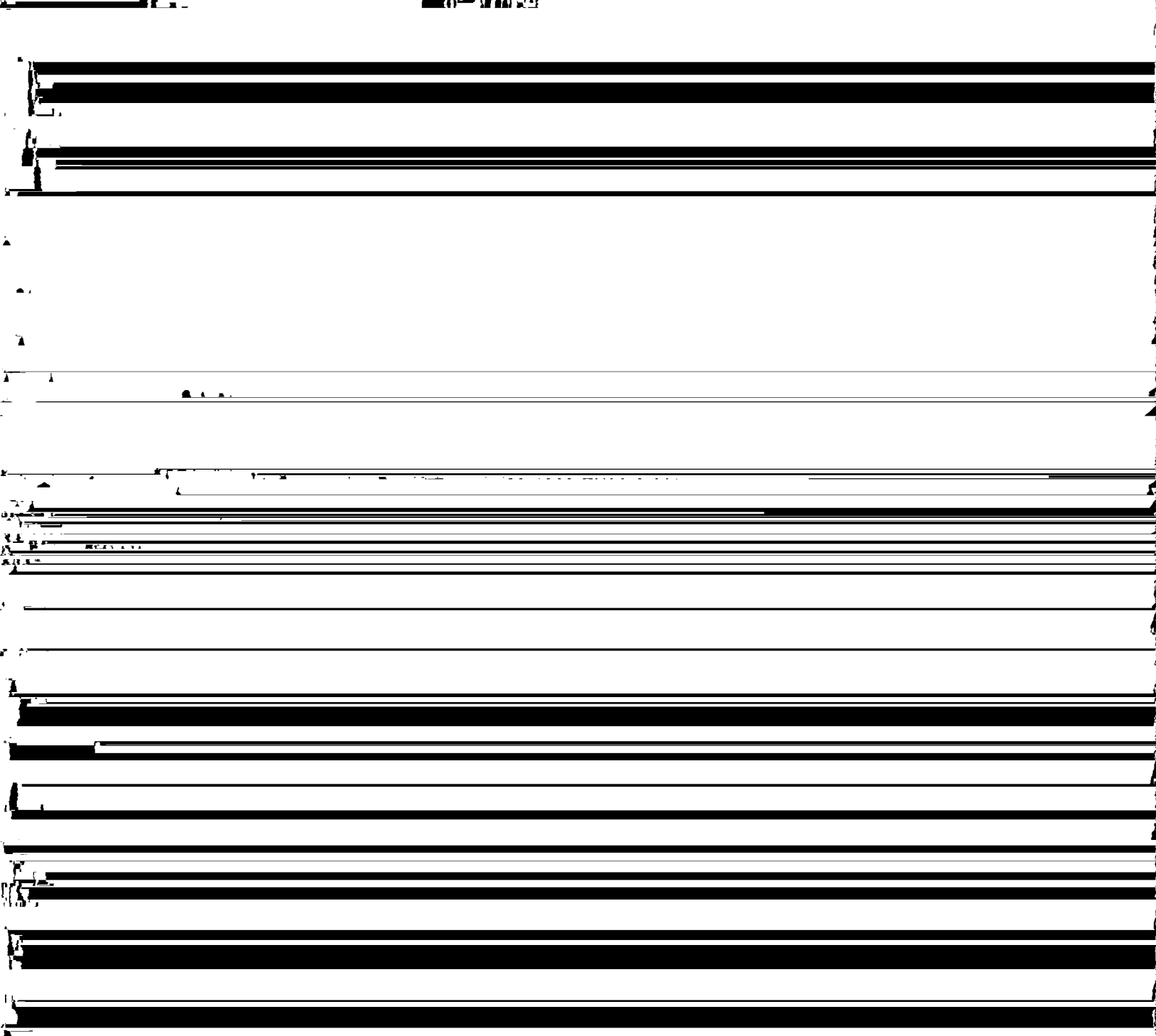
**ADOPT A RENAISSANCE SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PLAN FOR

**PERFORMANCE PLAN FOR THE SOUTH SHORE FINE ARTS ACADEMY**

1. Concept: The Board authorized the establishment of South Shore Fine Arts Academy ("OSFAA")

as a Defunct of the OSFAA. The Board of the OSFAA is the OSFAA. The OSFAA is the OSFAA.

The mathematics curriculum at SSFAA will utilize Math Trailblazers, a program that is integrated with other disciplines, especially science and language arts. Students will explore mathematics by drawing pictures; gathering, organizing, and graphing data; and analyzing their results.

**6. Accountability Plan.** SSFAA student performance will be annually evaluated by the Chief Executive Officer or designee based on the accountability standards, criteria and indicators set out in the

Board's School Performance, Remediation and Probation Policy. SSFAA has also identified the following individual goals for their first five years of operation and shall be reviewed annually to determine progress towards these goals:

- 90% of students who have been at SSFAA for 5 years will score at the meets or exceeds levels on

the ISAT.

- The average daily attendance rate will be 95% or better each year beginning in the 2009-10 year.
