eligible to receive honorary high school diplomas from the Chicago Public Schools.


INTRODUCTION To establish a policy for issuing high school graduation diplomas to World War II and Korean Conflict Veterans pursuant to Public Act 92-446, signed into law by Governor Ryan on August 26, 2001, and effective January 1, 2002.

PURPOSE: The Board wishes to honor veterans of foreign conflicts for their considerable contributions

and sacrifices and, in particular, to recognize those veterans who sacrificed their schooling to serve their country. Public Acts 92-446 and 96-0088 confer upon and authorize school boards the power to award high


