

**RESOLUTION RE: APPOINTMENT OF TEACHER REPRESENTATIVES TO
LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCILS TO FILL TEACHER REPRESENTATIVE VACANCIES**

FOR THE TERM OF OFFICE ENDING JUNE 30, 2010

WHEREAS, the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) has adopted the Illinois School Code (105 ILCS 5/34-2.1(l)) which requires the Board of Education to

Education to appoint 2 teachers to each Local School Council after considering the preferences of the school staff as ascertained through a non-binding advisory poll and to exercise absolute discretion in the appointment process; and

WHEREAS, non-binding advisory polls have been conducted at the schools identified below to ascertain the preferences of the school staffs regarding the appointment of teachers to fill teacher representative vacancies on the local school councils of those attendance centers; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-2.1(l), the results of the non-binding advisory polls have been forwarded to the Board for consideration in its exercise of absolute discretion in the
