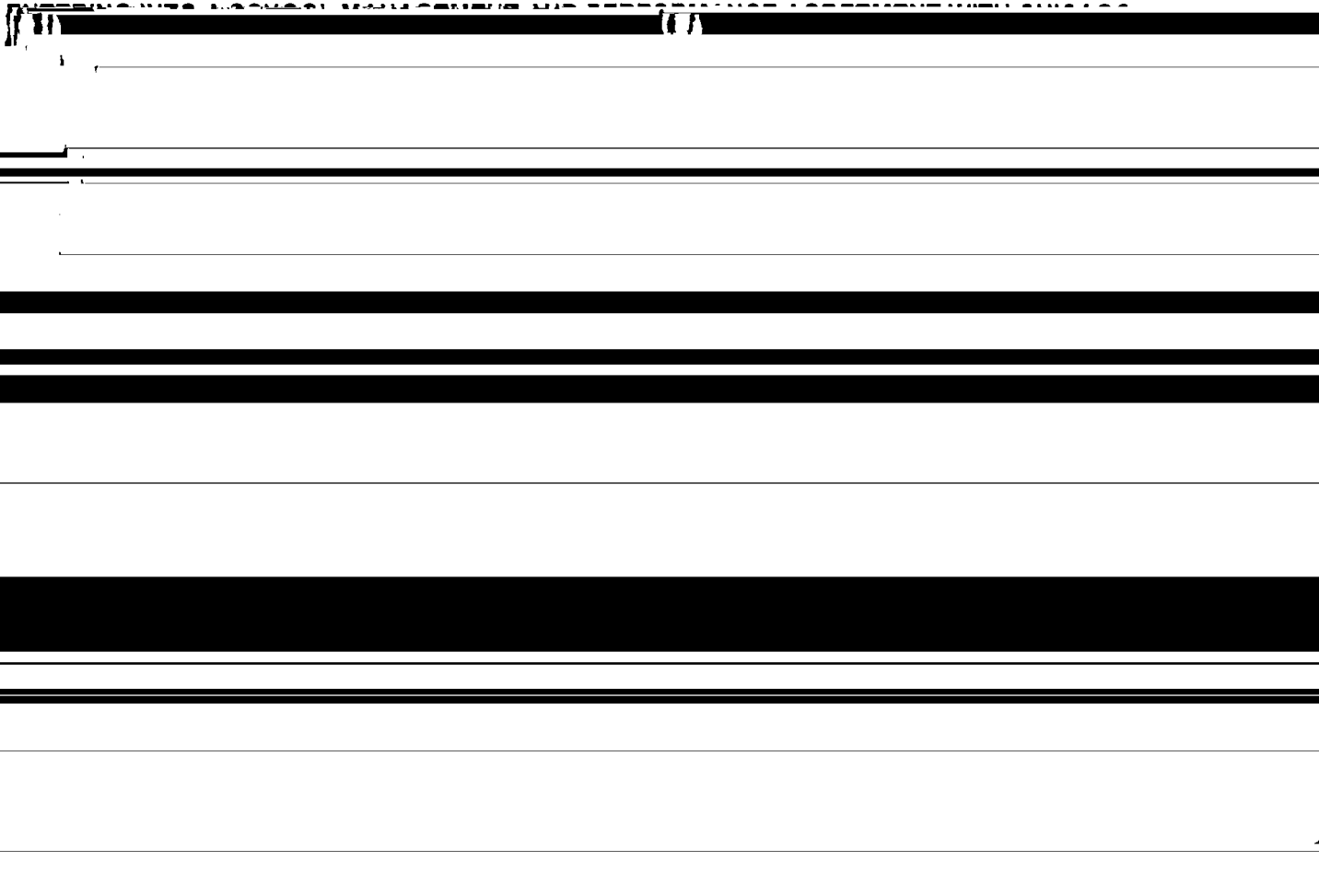

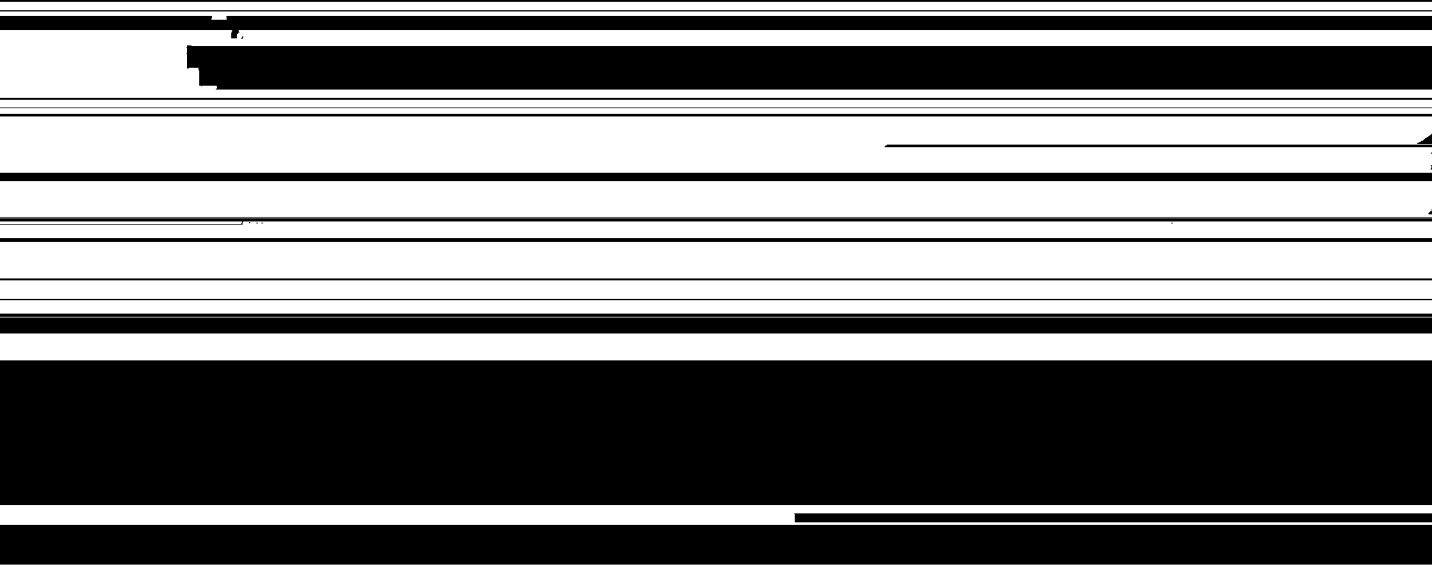
**APPROVE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CHICAGO HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS AND**



**HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Approve the establishment of the Chicago High School for the Arts, at a location to be determined, and approve entering into a School Management and Performance Agreement with the Chicago High School



as a Contract School as described in the Renaissance Policy. The Board hereby designates the Chicago

High School for the Arts as an alternative school pursuant to 105 ILCS 5/34-2.4b. This site will require Chicago High School for the Arts to share its facility with Pershing West Middle School. The two schools will share their facility in accordance with the Board's Shared Facility Policy, 05-0126-PO1.

Chicago High School for the Arts will be located at 3743W. Avenue Blvd. Facilities with the 2044, 2049

Advisory Body: A school advisory body will be established in a timely manner pursuant to 105 ILCS 5/34-2.4b and the Board's Renaissance School Policy in the following manner: the CEO or his designee, in consultation with the Chicago High School of the Arts shall develop the composition and duties of the advisory body for approval by the Board. Such requirements shall be included in the agreement with the Chicago High School of the Arts. The members of the advisory body will be appointed by the Board upon the recommendation of the CEO or his designee.

School Management Description: At a minimum, the School Management and Performance Agreement

will address student academic outcomes and financial and management practices of the school and shall

**PERSONNEL IMPLICATIONS:** As a contract school Chicago High School for the Arts will employ its

own principal, teachers and staff.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

Inspector General – Each Party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel

necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the Provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of or the letting of contracts to former


