

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	Communications Arts & Sciences Elementary School ("Bradwell") at a cost not to exceed \$300,000.00 \$102,464.76 for the first year with supplemental annual compensation on a per-pupil basis of \$420 for the operation of Myra Bradwell Communications Arts & Sciences Elementary School. A School Management Consulting Agreement is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by and no payment shall be made to AUSL prior to execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event an agreement is not executed by the Board and AUSL within 120 days of the plant of this Board Report Information participant to this agreement is attended by the services.
