

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

Approve the renewal of the Charter School Agreement with the Youth Connection Charter School (YCCS) for an additional five-year period. A new Charter School Agreement applicable to this renewal term will be negotiated. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written

Charter School Agreement is not executed by the Board and the charter school's governing board within 120 days of the date of this Board Report. The agreement authorized herein will only take effect upon certification by the Illinois State Board of Education. Information pertinent to this renewal is stated below.



school shall remain at 3,500 students. A public hearing on the proposed changes was held on Tuesday, August 18, 2009. The hearing was recorded and a summary report is available for review.

On September 28, 2009, YCCS submitted a proposal to establish a new high school campus. YCCS

King Drive and to increase their overall at capacity enrollment by 250 students to 3750. The campus is scheduled to onen in January 2011 and in its first year will serve 150 students in grades 9-12. The school

will grow to serve 250 students in grades 9-12 at capacity.

In June 2010 VCCS submitted a material modification to relocate the Mest Town Academy Alternative
