

**APPROVE EXERCISING THE FIRST OPTION TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT WITH HEALTH CARE**

**PREFERRED PROVIDER ORGANIZATION (PPO) SERVICES**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Approve exercising the first option to renew the agreement with Health Care Service Corporation d/b/a Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois to provide Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) services to the Office of Human Capital at a cost for the option period not to exceed \$10,000,000.00. A written document exercising this option is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Vendor during the option period prior to the execution of the written document. The authority granted herein shall

automatically rescind in the event a written document is not executed within 100 days of the date of this

**SCOPE OF SERVICES**

administrative services and claim for the Board's self-insured health plan.

**DELIVERABLES**

Vendor will continue to provide access to a PPO network of medical providers and monthly experience reports.

**OUTCOMES**

Vendor services will continue to result comprehensive and affordable healthcare coverage through contracted discounts and prepaid provider arrangements for the Board's self-insured health program for Chicago Public Schools and the Board enrollees.

**COMPENSATION**

Vendor shall be paid a network access/administration fee as set out in the written agreement with the Board.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS**

Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one-year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of

office.
