**RECONSTITUTE WENDELL SMITH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND REMOVE AND REPLACE THE
WENDELL SMITH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STAFF INCLUDING THE PRINCIPAL**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

That effective June 30, 2012, the Chicago Board of Education ("Board") approve the reconstitution of Wendell Smith Elementary School (School ID 609978) ("Smith"), located at 744 East 103rd Street, Chicago, Illinois, and remove and replace the staff, including the principal.

Statutory Authority: Pursuant to Section 5/34-8.3(d) of the Illinois School Code, 105 ILCS 5/34-8.3(d), and following the opportunity for a public hearing, the Chief Executive Officer ("CEO") of the Chicago

Public Schools may recommend the reconstitution of a school on probation for at least one year and after failing to make adequate progress in correcting deficiencies.

Procedural History: On or about November 30, 2011, the CEO gave written notice of his proposal to reconstitute Smith in accordance with Section 5/34-8.3(d) of the Illinois School Code to:

- (a) the parents of Smith students;
- (b) the Smith staff; and
- (c) Smith's Local School Council members.
