OUTCOMES: The Algebra Initiative Coursework program will result in an increased number of certified algebra teachers in the middle grades. This creates increased opportunities for students to access a

more rigorous mathematics program of study, such as enrollment in advanced mathematics courses as freshmen, which sets them on the pathway to enroll in advanced mathematics courses in high school and
