Institutes at a total cost not to exceed \$131,253. Vendor was selected on a non-competitive basis: the non-competitive request was presented to the Non-Competitive Procurement Review Committee, and

DELIVERABLES:

Through federal funding provided by ESAP/ATL as a component of the National Security Language

Initiative (NSLI), Consultant's faculty and staff will provide two (2) intensive language institutes with 30 students in each language. Students are provided with four (4) hours of intensive language instruction every day during the month of July 2013. Additionally, Students will be provided with cultural learning

~~Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current~~


