**AUTHORIZE THE EXTENSION OF THE AGREEMENT WITH KRONOS INCORPORATED FOR
SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE MAINTENANCE**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the extension of the agreement with Kronos Incorporated ("Kronos" or "Vendor") for the purchase



OPTION PERIODS REMAINING:

There are no option periods remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Kronos will continue to provide critical maintenance on the WorkForce Timekeeper system and depot repair maintenance on the smart converter and keypad system. Kronos will continue to provide software support to ensure the operating systems function properly, and will provide quarterly optimizations and necessary process documentations. This maintenance consists of program corrections and enhancements that

Kronos may develop during this extension term as long as the Board's maintenance fee is current.

DELIVERABLES:

Kronos will continue to provide critical maintenance on the WorkForce TimeKeeper system and depot repair maintenance on the smart converter and keypad system. Kronos will continue to provide software support to ensure the operating system function properly, and will provide quarterly optimizations and necessary process documentations. This maintenance consists of program corrections and enhancements that Kronos may develop during this extension term as long as the Board's maintenance fee is current.

OUTCOMES:

Kronos' services will result in the WorkForce TimeKeeper systems being maintained properly and functioning properly. Services will also result in ITS and Payroll Services having the necessary hardware and software support to ensure the proper functioning of the operating system.

COMPENSATION:

Kronos shall be paid in two equal installments of \$157,750.57 each; the total cost for this extension period shall not exceed \$315,501.15.

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written extension document. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the extension document. Authorize the Chief
