
## AMEND BOARD REPORT 14-0625-PR37 AUTHORIZE FIRST RENEWAL AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS VENDORS TO PROVIDE SAFE PASSAGE SERVICES FOR DESIGNATED NEIGHBORHOODS

## THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize first renewal agreements with various vendors to provide Safe Passage Services in designated neighborhoods in an effort to target resources towards schools which are most at risk at a total cost not to exceed \$8,930,000.00 \$9,732,000 in the aggregate.
