THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize a new agreement with Simplex Grinnell to provide repair, preventive maintenance and inspection
of all Type I (Ansul) and Type II (Exhaust Hoods) in CDC facilities on behalf of Nutrition Support Services

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Simplex Grinnell will ensure all Type I (Ansul Fire Suppression Systems) and Type II (Exhaust Hoods) can operate at optimal efficiency for the prevention of kitchen fires and the removal of heat exhaust from all

preventive maintenance charge the systems as needed; complete repair on an as needed basis on all

GENERAL CONDITIONS:
