APPROVE SETTLEMENT RECOMMENDATION IN HILL v. BOARD OF EDUCATION

(CASE NO. 009-0076)

GENERAL COUNSEL REPORTS THE FOLLOWING SETTLEMENT:

DESCRIPTION: Law Department attorneys have tentatively reached a settlement subject to Board

approval, in connection with a lawsuit filed by Brent Hill in the Illinois Human Rights Commission. The settlement would dispose of all claims, attorneys' fees and costs associated with the underlying lawsuit. The General Counsel recommends approval of the settlement, which calls for the payment of \$125,000.00 (one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars and zero cents) for all of Hill's claims, including attorneys' fees and costs. Additionally for twelve months the Board will assist Hill in obtaining interviews
