

AMEND BOARD REPORT 16-0427-PR7
**AUTHORIZE A NEW AGREEMENT WITH AMER-I-CAN ENTERPRISE II, INC FOR JOB
PREPAREDNESS TRAINING THROUGH AUDITORIUM SEATING RENOVATION SERVICES**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorizing new agreement with Amer-I-Can Enterprise II, Inc to provide job preparedness training

through auditorium seating renovation services to the Department of Facilities at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of this report. Vendor was selected on a competitive basis pursuant to Board Rule 7-2. A written agreement for Vendor's services is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by Vendor and no payment shall be made to Vendor prior to the execution of their written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. Information pertinent to this

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendor will coach high school students in basic work place job skills, including being on time, proper attire, acceptable behavior while at work, working independently and in teams, interactions with co-workers and other on-the-job skills required to be successful at work. Additionally, students will be

Vendor will provide mentoring and on-the-job work place training to approximately 300 students per year.

OUTCOMES:

Vendor's services will result in providing career development for students and possibly internship opportunities.

COMPENSATION:

Vendor shall be paid as follows:

Cost per chair to refurbish or replace. Estimated annual costs for the three (3) year term shall not exceed \$4,700,000 ~~\$1,800,000~~, FY16, FY17, FY18 and FY19.

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorizing the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General. Each party to the agreement shall understand that to comply with 405 ILCS

5/34-13, 1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain

investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts. The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the
