RESOLUTION REGARDING INSPECTOR GENERAL NICHOLAS SCHULER

Inspector General of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago (the "Board") by the Mayor of the City of Chicago;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Rahm Emanuel, Mayor of the City of Chicago, appointed Nicholas Schuler as the Board's Inspector General effective December 9, 2014, for a term ending June 30,

WHEREAS Section 34-12.4 of the Illinois School Code provides that the Inspector General "shall

have the power to subpoena witnesses and compel the production of books and papers pertinent to an investigation authorized by this Code" but does not outline the mechanism for enforcement of a subpoena issued by the Inspector General; and

WHEREAS Section 34-11 of the Illinois School Code provides that the Board "by a majority vote
