**AUTHORIZE A NEW AGREEMENT WITH GENESYS WORKS CHICAGO  
FOR TECHNICAL SUPPORT SERVICES**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Authorize a new agreement with Genesys Works Chicago to provide low cost technical support services to schools using CPS graduate interns at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of

Source Committee on February 4, 2020 and approved by the Chief Procurement Officer. Prior to approval as a Single Source, the item was published on the Procurement website on February 2, 2020, found here:

**DELIVERABLES:**

Vendor will provide CPS with trained college interns whom will work in schools to provide supplementary technology support services.

**OUTCOMES:**

Vendor's services will result in a low cost alternative for schools needing additional technology support. It will also provide professional opportunities for local college students whom are all CPS alumni.

**COMPENSATION:**

Vendor shall be paid as follows:

FY21 \$500,000

**AUTHORIZATION:**

Authorizing the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement.

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted May 25, 2011 (11-0525-PO2), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).





